

## **Adrian White**

Adrian taught physics to A-level and beyond for over 30 years and retired after 15 years as head teacher of a large secondary school (Wetherby High School) and then worked for 6 years for the University of Leeds in post-graduate teacher training.

After retirement he served in several positions on the committee of Wetherby Camera Club, where he is still a member, having been Chairman and also the first webmaster of the club, a position he held for over 8 years.

His involvement in digital Audio Visual using WnSoft's Picture to Exe dates back some 9 years. Having been the Secretary of the Leeds Audio Visual Group for 5 years, he is now its President and helps run its popular annual show and workshop.

His AV shows include experiments with animation and the exploration of aspects of local history but it is his interest in music and his photography which are the essential backgrounds to his work. Some of his recent sequences have also explored the work of very disparate composers such as Ralph Vaughan Williams and Edward Kennedy (Duke) Ellington.

In addition to sequences which have done well at Club Level he will present some specially constructed sequences which explore various aspects of Audio Visual. Adrian's main motivation in producing sequences is the enjoyment he gains from blending pictures, words and music to tell a story or explore an emotion and he will share seek to share this enjoyment with the audience. His experience in education supports his construction of his presentations and means he is always happy to answer any questions about technique, choice of music, processing of images etc.
